CUSTOM FURNITURE PROCESS

Have you ever wondered what goes into buying a custom piece of furniture?

1. It all starts with an idea or an inspiration piece from the client.
2. Followed by follow up questions to define the scope.
3. An initial design sketch is created and shared with the client.
4. A client approves the design or provides additional follow up for minor changes.
5. Design sketch is modified according to minor changes and repeat step 5.
6. One or multiple quotes are provided based on wood choices or finishing options.
7. If multiple wood and finish types are being reviewed by the client, samples are created and sent to the client for their review.
8. Client selects their preferred wood and finish option.
9. Invoice is sent to client for Initial 67% or Full payment
10. Client pays invoice.
11. Material is purchased.
12. Lumber is milled and any metal work has begun.
13. Rough assembly of subparts and initial shaping.
14. Client update.
15. Subparts are assembled into larger parts and further shaped.
16. Sand, Sand, Sand
17. Full glue up or assembly of piece.
18. Sand, Sand, and Final Sand
19. Staining/Applying finish to piece.
20. Product photograph.
21. Packaging
22. Final 33% payment received for completion of project prior to delivery.
23. Finished product delivered to client.



KEEPING TABLE TOPS FLAT

There are several things that go into keeping a table top flat. First and foremost stable and properly dried material is required. Every edge also needs to be at 90 degrees to the face. Any slight angle on the edges will create stress in the top that will want to curl to accommodate the slight angle. The entire surface needs to be sealed evenly with the finish to ensure that moisture is evenly leaving and entering the wood to limit the risks of cracks or warping. Some newer advances to ensuring a flat table top is the addition of steel 'C' channels placed in grooves cross wise on the underside of the top. This creates a zero reference point for the wood, with wide holes that the threaded bolts go through to allow the wood to expand and contract along the channels. Additionally, kerfs running most of the length of the table top will act as a fail safe to the steel 'C' channels. The kerfs break up the wood fibers into smaller sections on the underside. This means a smaller surface expands, if the 'C' channels fail, while the top has an unbroken surface that expands up to a half inch across a 46" quarter sawn top. This would control any warping of the table by forcing the table to curl down slightly allowing the table to still be used versus an uncontrolled warp or twist.



ANDREEN TABLE



The Andreen table is the pinnacle of design and function done in association with clients. This is our most popular product with clients and is easily scaled to fit any location. The main feature of the table is the beveled edge on the underside of the table top creating the allusion of a thinner top. The base is made from interlocking rectangular legs that can be adjusted to fit the number of chairs required and their placement.

MARA TABLE

The Mara table is a unique design that incorporates an inverted solid wood pyramid in a steel base. The pyramid is made up of individual layers of solid wood that are cut to precise dimensions and angles so each course fits the course above and below with little sanding required once assembled. This table is perfect as a statement or a center piece as a coffee or entry table.

The Mara table can be made in rectangular or square formats with the size limited by the weight of the pyramid. A max weight of 100lbs for the pyramid will ensure that the piece can be easily moved as needed without being a hazard to the mover.





MASTRUD TABLE

The Mastrud table is our signature piece. It features a base comprised of fourteen different parts that are rough shaped by power tools and finished shaping by hand by our skilled artisans. The center column is shaped to give the appearance that one leg flows to the other. The Mastrud table comes in two different styles from a high leg and low leg versions. It can also be built as an entry, sofa, or scaled to a dining table.



ZENZ STOOL

The Zenz stool is one of our more unique pieces. Featuring three distinct comfort features: The foot rest is placed at 16" below the top of the seat at a more natural resting point, the back rest is positioned and angled to provide the optimal amount of support for the low back, and the seat which has the front edge shaped to contour the back of the legs rather than dig in and a gentle slope that encourages you to sit all the way back. With all three features working together the Zenz stool provides hours of comfortable sitting. One of the more unique features however, is the three leg design.



CINDER SOFA TABLE

The Cinder sofa table features straight lines and tapered legs. The legs are splayed to provide a stable base with the width of the legs tapered from the top to the feet. The lower shelf provides the strength of the base to maintain stability when in use. There is an added detail of the cut out square in the legs that can be customized to any shape you require.



CINDER SIDE TABLE

The Cinder side table is a simple table that fits in most surroundings. Its clean lines and tapered legs are inviting to anyone. These tables can be custom sized to any size you need. It can be made with or without the lower shelf and with or without the corner brackets.


SELBERG BENCH

The Selberg bench is a unique style with the seat carved into a single or glued up slab. The carved seat is sloped to the back encouraging person to sit all the way back. The main feature of this bench are the handles on the ends. They act as an easy place to grab when moving the bench, a place to help lift you up out of the bench, and tie the legs together creating a strong joint.



ANZO TABLE

The Anzo table is a basic table featuring bread board ends, which help keep the flat. It also features steel 'C' channels that are attached to channels in the underside that also help to maintain the flatness of the table top. We offer a variety of metal or wood legs that can accompany the table top.



PAIGE COFFEE TABLE

The Paige coffee table is a simple yet durable table. With the legs and table top joined by hand cut dovetails. It provides a durable joint and unique look that will last for generations. The tables can be sized to any dimensions required to fit your location.
